Transmission Gully Motorway Update

1. Purpose

To update the Committee on progress with the Transmission Gully Motorway (TGM) project.

2. Significance of the decision

The matters for decision in this report **do not** trigger the significance policy of the Council or otherwise trigger section 76(3)(b) of the Local Government Act 2002.

3. Background

The TGM is a significant part of the Western Corridor Plan. The Committee has asked for regular updates of this project, as it progresses through its various stages. Transit New Zealand, as the lead agency, will provide these updates for the Committee.

4. Project update

Since the last report, the Principal Project Manager and the Property Manager have joined the TGM team, bringing the team up to full strength.

The last remaining Stage 1 contract to be let, for the Scheme Assessment, is currently in the final evaluation stages and expected to be awarded soon.

The Preliminary Geotechnical Assessment contract is progressing to programme with initial site mapping due for completion late June. Access agreements are being put in place with landowners for the intrusive drilling phase of the works.

To provide more detailed monitoring of progress, an updated co-ordinated programme covering all work streams is also currently being developed.

5. **Communication**

Transit New Zealand will continue to manage communications associated with this project.
