The NZCPS

- Purpose Sustainable management of the coastal environment
- Prepared under the RMA
- To be "given effect" in regional and district plans and in the assessment of resource consents



Policy topics of note:

Treaty of Waitangi

 Recognise traditional relationship of tangata whenua with the coastal environment

Precautionary approach

If effects are uncertain, unknown or little understood

Integration

Co-ordinated management of resources



Policy topics cont'd

Biodiversity

Avoid adverse effects on threatened or at risk species


Water quality

- Improve degraded water quality

Sedimentation

Control the impacts of land use on the coastal environment

Policy topics cont'd



Discharge of contaminants

- Manage discharges to water in the coastal environment
- Avoid the discharge of untreated human sewage to water in the coastal environment
