Policies

- what we are going to do (actions)
- who does it (and who pays)
- where we are going to do it (spatial distribution)
- how we are going to do it (implementation)



Implementing Management Options

- Investment
- Regulation
- Education
- Collective actions
- Good Management Practice



Investment

- Infrastructure- hard and soft
- Incentives
- Programmes (often include education and regulatory elements)
- Range of scales- government, local government, industry, community, individual



Regulation-rules

- Water take, and discharge limits
- Water allocation
- Discharge (contaminant) allocation
- Discharge standards
- Land use practices



Education

- General or targeted
- Provided by range of agencies and scales
- Individual upskilling
- Element of education required in every solution



Collective Actions

- Catchment community groups
- Have a range of names including care groups, land care groups, water user groups etc
- Collective decisions of action on the ground and often collective action
- Not just land owners




Good Management Practice

- Timeframes to reach the objective and any stages along the way
- How much change is possible at each stage
- Who pays and when
- Transitional steps or actions needed to reach future stages
