
The water allocation framework









How is water allocated when it becomes available?

- on common expiry dates for resource consents
- when water is given up



Re-allocation of water



Current water availability at full allocation

No water is available to new users when resource consents expire because existing users trump new users = grandparenting



What the RMA says

When considering an application [for renewal of resource consent] ... a consent authority must have regard to the value of the investment of the existing consent holder (RMA s104 (2A))



Key considerations

- How will the Committee address allocation on expiry of resource consents?
- Potential allocation approaches:
 - status quo
 - market e.g. auction, tender
 - administrative e.g. priority allocation system, user groups, ballot,
- Equity vs existing investment?
