Decisions on non-notified resource consents applications

1. Purpose

To report on decisions made under delegated authority on non-notified resource consent applications. This report covers the period 26 April 2014 to 24 May 2014.

2. Applications processed

A total of 32 resource consents were received during the period, with 37 being approved in the period. This compares with 54 consents that were approved for the same period last year. One application was returned as incomplete under section 88.

WAR140279 – Wellington Fish & Game Council was granted consent for the ongoing operation, two weir structures and the associated damming and diversion water from the Otakura Stream. These works are to provide for wild life habitat values and improve hunting opportunity in the JK Donald Reserve on the eastern shore of Lake Wairarapa.
