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Decisions on non-notified resource consents applications

1. Purpose

To report on decisions made under delegated authority on non-notified resource consent applications. This report covers the period from 14 November to 31 December 2015.

2. Applications processed

A total of **69** resource consents were received during the period 14 November to 31 December 2015, with **47** being approved in the period. This compares with **42** consents that were approved for the same period last year. **Two** applications were returned as incomplete under section 88.

The consents approved are summarised in the table below:

3. Consent trends

Given the time of year, we saw the annual trend of an increase in applications to drill bores.

4. Non-notified consents of interest

Wellington City Council – WGN160050 – Breaker Bay coastal protection structure – in this period we assessed and granted an application for coastal protection works at Breaker Bay, Wellington. Erosion to the road was caused during storms in 2013 and 2015. The works will see a rock revetment constructed along a 125 metre section. Conditions on planting and beach monitoring were imposed. Works are expected to start in early 2016.
